Capital Projects:

This past winter the offseason was an especially busy one, which yielded numerous significant accomplishments.







Phase III Interior Renovations a total of 22 guest rooms in the Abel & Prada Houses delivered on-time and within budget.

We developed a comprehensive Information Technology (IT) Project.

The IT project's scope covered: fiber optic signal throughout the resort campus, hardwiring new internet cable, installing dedicated Access Points to 90 guest rooms, configuring two standalone exclusive fiber networks; a network for ethernet high-definition TV service and a network for High-Speed Wi-Fi service.

In addition, the IT project's overall scope was to procure and implement a new cloud based Property Management Software package. We selected a new software package, namely Viewpoint, along with booking engine platform and payment gateway. The new guest room photos taken during a recent photo shoot are featured via the current website's BOOK NOW buton.

The Viewpoint software package includes an owner portal platform that enables the **convenience of online paymen** t on owner accounts. The owner portal is still in development. We're working behind the scenes to **launch our new website** with the owners portal by October 1, 2023.

Nightly Room Rates:

Our **comp-set** is as tight as ever during the busy season. Several new hotels are now open in Edgartown,

some start at \$1,200 a night for a standard guest room. We implemented a rate increase April-November for all room types.

We remain quietly confident in our market share. We are well poised by virtue of our unique location & amenities, our recent spectacular renovations and perhaps most notably by virtue of our authentic, friendly and professional team members who consistently deliver high standards of guest service. Transient Dockage Rates:


This season we increased our
